James is also planning to be gone for two weeks serving his soldiers on annual training. In addition, he will be resuming his role teaching our adult Sunday School class. It is going to be a busy month for both of us!

If we survive all of that, we're looking forward to having several more deputation meetings in July. We are praising God that someone has offered to provide the projector we need for these meetings!

After July, we have a bit of a break. We are praying about when God would have us move to Cache County, but part of that depends on our support levels. Right now we're sitting around 20%.
