Some minor progress has been made on the health front for James. He just started physical therapy for balance and mobility, and we are encouraged by the therapist's optimism concerning full recovery. He also has another upcoming appointment with a different neurologist, who will hopefully do more diagnostic work and continue nailing down the official diagnosis.

We have been able to continue ministering in Cokeville on Sundays and Tuesdays, and are so thankful for our partners, the Adanks, who have helped and ministered there several weekends while James was away for Guard duty and a ministry opportunity. He has enjoyed many one-on-one opportunities with his soldiers during drill weekends, as living in God's strength at this time (for both of us) has become evident to unbelievers. He also had the privilege to minister with the Clancys at First Baptist Church of Notus, Idaho, and speak for their services and Harvest Banquet. Noah Adank assisted in this venture by graciously driving James over and back. It was good to see the growth God has brought to the church in Notus, as well as their vision to see other churches planted locally and throughout the region.

We are grateful that Elizabeth's strength seems to have held up, especially as she's taken on all the driving and other responsibilities during this time. Only through the goodness and mercy of God has this been possible, and we praise Him for what He is doing. She has also found time to work and continue doing art, and has been recently doing some conceptual paintings on creation. While she is enjoying these creative pursuits greatly, she is also excited to see how God might use those interests once we get to Cache Valley, where art is a popular interest and there are many avenues for interacting with other artists in the community.

We continue to search for housing in Cache County. The market is still very
